
Dear Sir:



Hundreds of Hours of Unseen Labor are Found on Every Page

Someone once “wore” each page!

Today, we take paper for granted.

It's everywhere — but 99% of it is made from wood pulp. Yet, the use of wood began in the year 1800! Previous to that time, paper was primarily made from old rags: shirts, pants, socks, coats, blankets and even underwear were all recycled. “Rag Men” of old drove their carts down the streets buying old clothing and bringing them to the paper mill.

German immigrant becomes crown jeweller to Queen Elizabeth

One of the most famous “Rag Men” and paper makers of England was a German immigrant named John Spielman.

He was so skilled at his craft that he was made “Goldsmith of our Jewelles” to not only Queen Elizabeth, but also her nephew King James I.

In 1589, he was granted the monopoly of paper making as well as the collection of cotton and linen rags and other items “...fit for making all sorts of white paper.”

The patent was renewed for 14 years in 1597 and it is almost certain that the paper to print the first King James Bibles came from Sir John Spielman's mill. He was knighted by King James himself in 1605.

A primer on “old time papermaking”



The Stamping of Rags



Step one — stamping

First, rags had to be reduced to their original fibers. Each cartload of old clothing was loaded into large wooden troughs, fitted with horse hair screens on one side. Above the troughs hung a series of wooden hammers with metal or wooden heads. Water from a nearby river flowed into the troughs both to flush clean the rags and actuate the hammers.

The first set of hammers or stampers were equipped with iron teeth which frayed the cloth while the horse hair screens prevented the escape of the recaptured fibres.

This same stamping and cleaning operation was repeated again with a finer set of stampers.

Finally, the partly beaten rags or “half-stuff” as it was called was poured into a third set of stampers usually made of wood. The running water was eliminated at this stage since much of the fine fibre would have been lost.

Step two — moulding

The rags were now reduced to a fibrous solution and poured into a vat.

Box-like moulds with cloth bottoms and wire meshes were dipped into this solution by “the vatman”. As he pulled it out, he would shake it gently from side to side and front to back making sure to evenly distribute the fibres. At this point, some of the water would drain off.

If you look closely at each page you can still see the “chain lines” formed by the imprint of the wire mesh on the newly formed sheets of paper!



French paper mill showing the large wooden screw press for squeezing the water out of the newly made sheets, the “spurs” of paper being hung to dry and the large stone hammers (left) to polish each sheet.



Next, the “coucher” would set the frame at an angle to let more water drain off. After a while, he would place the wet sheet of paper on a piece of felt. He would continue to interleave paper on felt until a pile of 144 was made. These wet sheets and felt dividers were then placed into a large wooden screw type press called a “press post” and the excess water was “squeezed out”.

Real teamwork

The bell rung and everyone in the mill showed up to help turn the screw of the great press post by means of a long wooden handle!

The “layman” would then remove, separate and pile the felts and sheets of paper.

The newly formed sheets were squeezed again and again until they attained the desired finish.

Then, 4 or 5 sheets at a time were placed between a set of wooden frames called “spurs”. The spurs insured that the sheets would dry flat while they were hung up in the “drying loft” of the mill.

Step three — sizing and finishing

Have you ever written on a piece of cloth? The ink is absorbed and “runs”. That’s why the paper makers had to seal their sheets with “sizing”.

The sheets were then hand dipped into this

gelatin like substance which was usually made by boiling the skins of animals.

After being dried, each sheet was “polished” by a huge glazing hammer which imparted an almost uniform surface over the entire sheet.

From their hands to yours

Each 380-year-old sheet of paper is a tribute to the long, damp and dimly lit hours the craftsmen at John Spielman’s mill endured.

The King James First Edition Pulpit Bible was printed in a “black letter” or “gothic” typeface.

It was patterned after the popular style of handwriting used in Germany, Holland and England during the 15th Century.

Each letter had to be hand carved or “cut” onto the end of a steel rod. The rods were then used to “punch” the image of the letter into chunks of softer brass. Sides were added to the brass to form an inch deep mold into which molten metal was poured and so, each piece of type was “cast”.

You can imagine how much time the “punch cutter” had to spend on each letter to make sure it was properly and uniformly made!



The Printing of a Literary Landmark

Printing and Publishing in 16th Century England — a Crown Sanctioned Monopoly

A handful of wealthy businessmen owned the exclusive rights to print certain classes of books. These exclusive rights were called “patents”, “licenses” or “privileges”.

Books like the ABC’s (and other books on grammar), the Psalms, and “Foxes Book of Martyrs” were very valuable “privileges” to own because they had mass appeal and a subject matter that could be sold year in and year out.

However, the single most valuable and by far the greatest “privilege” for any printer was that of the Bible. It was a perpetual “Best Seller”, but the cost of production was enormous. Especially the printing of a new edition.

The “burden” of a lifetime monopoly

The First Edition of the King James Bible was printed by Robert Barker “Printer to the King’s Most Excellent Majestie”, at the Barker family print shop in St. Paul’s Churchyard, London.

In 1599, Robert Barker was granted the Bible “patent” for life by Queen Elizabeth I (daughter of Henry VIII).

It was a patent that was actually passed on to him by his father, Christopher, who had been printing copies of the Geneva and Bishop’s Bibles (two of the 6 major English Bibles that preceded the King James).

All went well until the appearance of the King James or “Authorized Version” of the Bible. It was newly translated out of the original tongues and was probably welcomed by young Robert as a project with unlimited potential.

But the cost of production, both personally and economically was staggering.

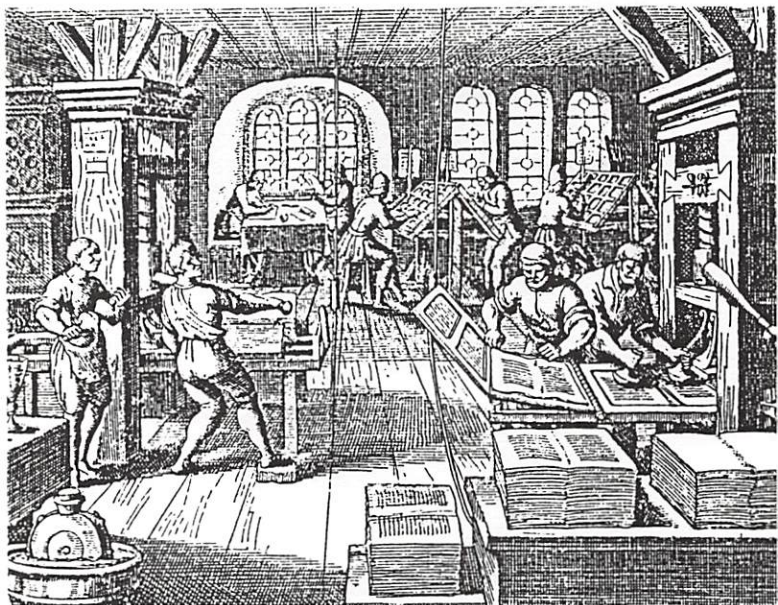
The requirements of the First Edition

1. This new Bible contained 774,746 words. There were millions of pieces of metal type that had to be hand set.
2. Baker didn’t have the luxury of printing from an already printed document. Each Page had to be typeset from a hand written manuscript. Therefore, it had to be proof read, revised and checked again and again.

3. It required approximately 2 tons of hand made paper (which Barker had to buy from Spielman’s mill).

4. In addition to the large folio size for distribution to churches, it had to be printed in smaller sizes also.

5. Most importantly, each copy was expected to be produced — WITHOUT ERROR! An error in a Bible is thousands of times more serious than an error in any other book because men’s immortal souls are at stake!

“I do yet groan under the burden of this book.”

So wrote Robert Barker in 1609 even as he was sending out proofs to be checked. The monumental project soon sapped all his wealth causing him to ease the burden by borrowing money from Bonham Norton and John Bill.

As part of the deal, Norton and Bill were to hold the patent for a year. However, at year’s end, Norton refused to yield the patent.

Barker lost the patent in 1617 only to regain and share it with Bill until 1621 when Norton again took over.

Barker sued Norton for control and after a nine year struggle finally settled with him by paying £8,000 to regain the privilege in 1629.

The "Wicked" Bible

Norton was furious. He was wealthy, manipulative and ruthless.

It is suspected that Norton bribed workmen in Barker's shop to omit the word "not" in the 7th commandment of Barker's 1631 edition of the King James Bible. This rendered the passage "Thou shalt commit adultery"!

Obviously, such a soul damning injection could not be tolerated and so the bibles were ordered to be recalled and burned.

The whole affair spelled financial ruin for Barker who, in 1634 was forced to lease his premises, equipment and even the patent itself to three men even more devious than Norton.

A Remarkable Achievement

In spite of the cloud that hung over the business side of the King James Bible the translation itself remains "The Noblest Monument of English Prose". It contained over 1400 pages, weighed nearly 20 pounds and was almost 5" thick!

The First Edition is referred to as a Pulpit Bible because it was produced in a large size and was "appointed to be read in the churches" from the pulpit.

It's production was remarkable in that the process and printing methods were virtually unchanged since the invention of printing with moveable type 155 years earlier.

Every tool, every piece of paper, each piece of type, each engraved headpiece and ornamental letter was made entirely by hand. The process was extremely time consuming, labor intensive and very expensive.

Individual pieces of metal type were placed into a metal frame called a "chase" to form the reverse image of the page it was transferred to.

Obviously, the typesetter had to layout each page — in reverse!

Once the type was set, the chase was placed upon a moveable bed and hand inked. A piece of paper was set in a wooden holder and placed over the type. Both were then slid under a flat plate called a "platten" attached to a large screw.

The platten was then screwed down forcing the paper onto the inked type.

The screw was then released; the bed slid out and the newly printed page was removed and allowed to air dry.

Every ornamental headpiece and ornate letter was hand carved into wood blocks. The original title page was etched into a copper plate by Cornelius Boel, a master engraver from Antwerp, Belgium.

The entire production of the First Edition was a painstakingly slow process that required expert care, organization and workmanship. Each page is a true work of art!

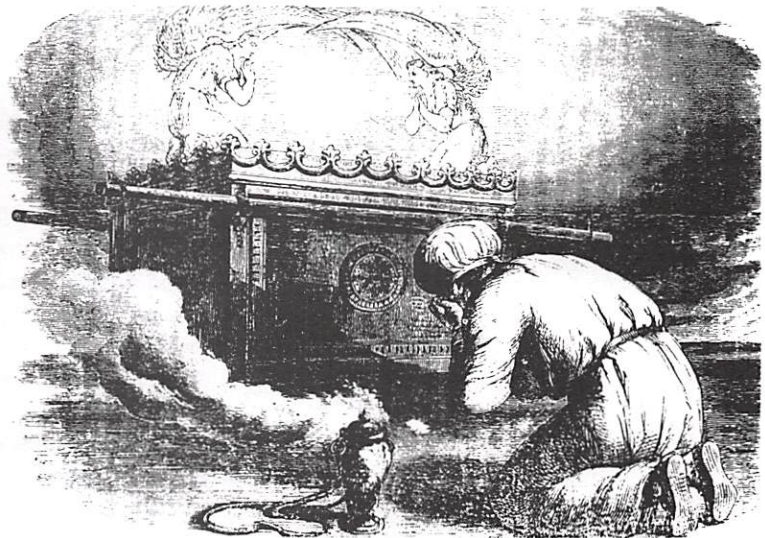

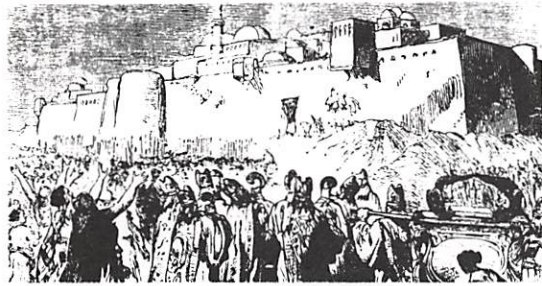

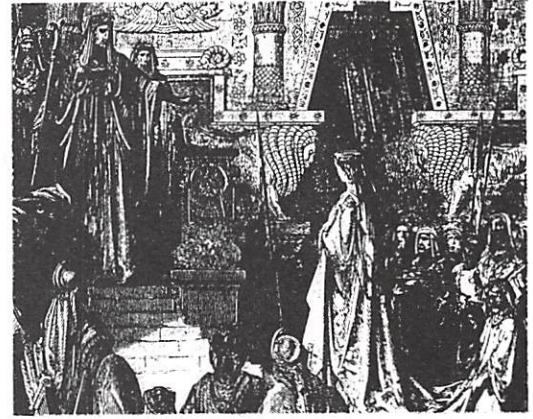

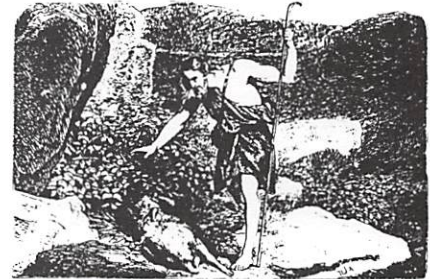

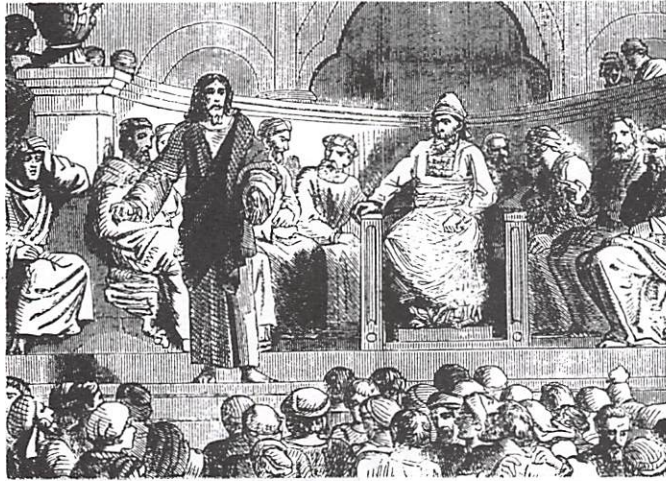

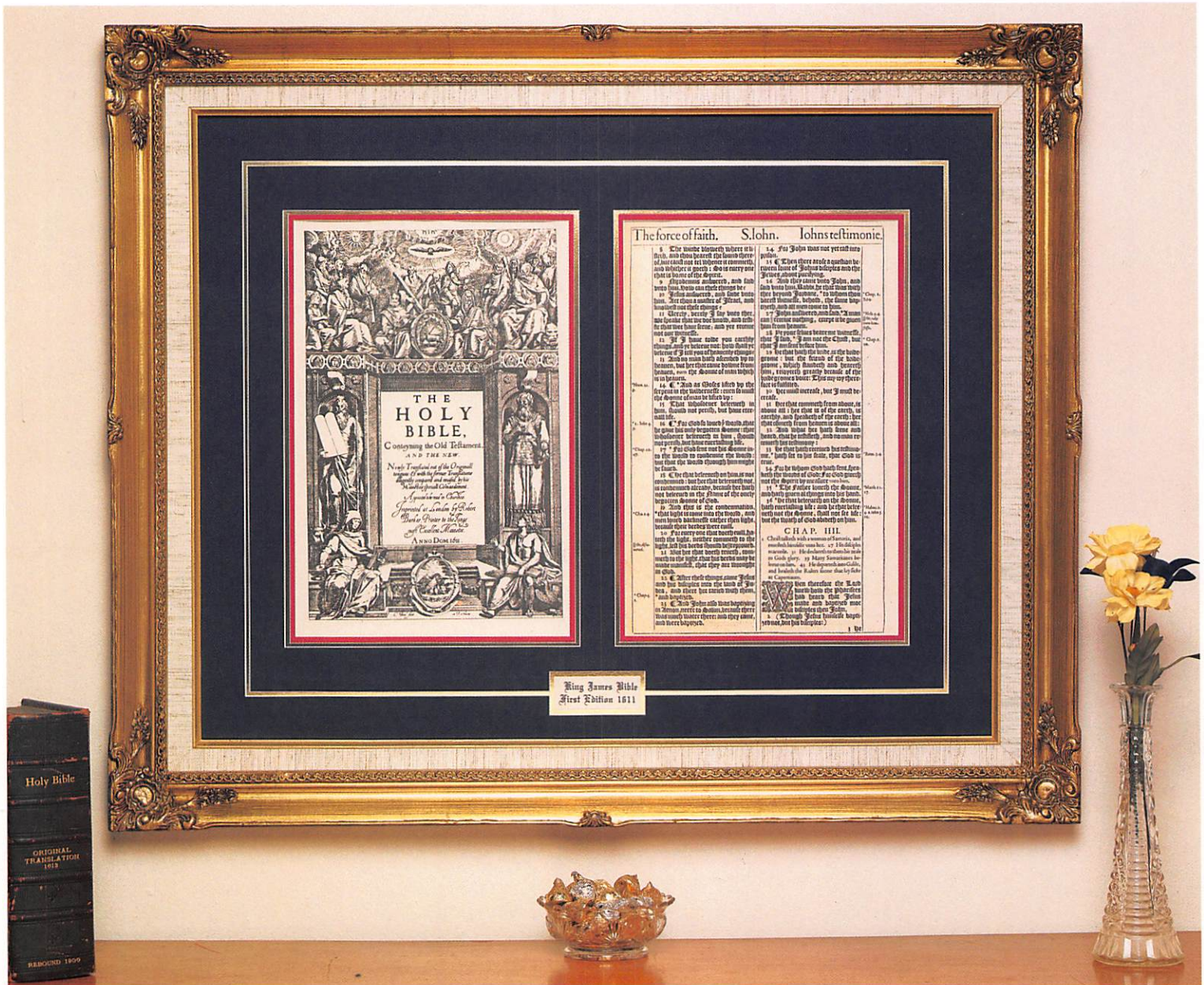
